

Modern dance and contemporary composition take on the energetic excitement of a sporting event in the electrifying **60x60 Dance**. This is a one-of-a-kind performance, where each minute of the hour features a new composer and a new choreographer: 60 minutes featuring 60 dance pieces set to 60 one-minute compositions. It might sound like a recipe for sensory overload but **60x60 Dance** has got pulses racing since 2007 in the U.S and in Canada. Now **60x60 Dance** celebrates its European debut this summer in London on Saturday 24 July.

Part of London's Open Weekend, this dance event of break neck speed and excitement, cannot be better placed than in Stratford - the heart of the developing Olympic City, **60x60 Dance** is fitting to celebrate the official two year countdown towards the Olympic and Paralympic Games 2012.

60x60, brainchild of Composer and Producer Robert Voisey, was originally conceived in 2003 as an electronic music project. It gained immediate international interest from composers of disparate musical backgrounds, and as the yeas progressed the project provided a natural vehicle for collaborating with other art forms. In 2007, 60x60 teamed up with choreographers and **60x60 Dance** was born. The project in its many its forms has since grown successfully across the globe, presenting in over 15 countries featuring more than 2500 artists and reaching an audience of more than 5000 people.

East London Dance is joining forces with Robert Voisey, Dance Co-ordinator Adriana Pegorer and Producer Silke Arnold to introduce **60x60 Dance** to London audiences. Over 200 composers from across the globe submitted music tracks to be selected for the London event. The show will involve more than 150 dancers with styles ranging from roller disco to Bboying to Contemporary to Salsa to BMX riding – with so much variety there is certainly something for everyone. Dance makers are coming from all across London, the UK and the world – China, France, the USA - to be part of **60x60 Dance** here in London.

East London Dance is the natural partner to co-produce **60x60 Dance**, having had a long and outstanding track record as the driving force in London's dance industry of innovative, risk-taking and challenging concepts such as Blueprint, Stylefest, Local International and many more.
